

# scientific rationale

Early diagnosis and customized management of colorectal cancer represent a continuous challenge. Cancer biology is not just a bench matter but represents a substantial advancement in predicting oncological outcomes. New screening methods are coming into practice representing one of the most cutting-edge areas. Reporting rectal cancer staging and restaging is fundamental to guide treatment. Rectal cancer therapy ranges from TNT to extended major surgery with a constant focus on new surgical technology and new tailored oncological therapy. Surgeons are becoming convinced that surgery and oncology should complete each other. Postoperative complications still represent a major issue that need to be managed promptly and adequately to limit their impact on short- and long-term outcomes.

Leading speakers in the field of colorectal surgery and oncology, forming an international scientific panel, will contribute to the scientific program of this congress that will take place in Verona on December 12th, 2025.
